Purpose of the Awards:

- Acknowledge and celebrate academic excellence.
- Provide formal recognition for achievements, valuable for curriculum vitae.
- Inspire learners to strive for excellence, raising overall achievement standards.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Minimum of two years of study at St. Anthony's.
- Academic excellence (above 90% in all subjects).
- Positive character and adherence to school values.
- Consistent attendance and punctuality.
- Demonstrated leadership qualities.
- Active participation in school activities (competitions, sports, cultural events).

Selection Process

The selection process includes:

- Initial Screening:** Ensuring applications meet eligibility criteria.
- Evaluation:** Assessing academic records, extracurricular achievements, and personal statements.
- Panel Decision:** A committee of members, administrators, and potentially teacher/learner representatives makes the final decision.
- Announcement:** The winner is announced at an official event.

What is the Best Learner Award?

This prestigious award honors an all-rounder learner who demonstrates:

- **Exceptional academic performance:** Achieving 'A' in all subjects, showcasing subject mastery and active engagement in learning.
- **Positive character:** Exhibiting ethical behavior, respect towards peers and staff, and adherence to school values.
- **Consistent attendance and punctuality:** Maintaining regular attendance and timely arrival for classes and events.
- **Leadership qualities:** Taking initiative, participating in extracurricular activities, and demonstrating responsibility.
- **Active participation:** Contributing to all intra & inter-school competitions, sports, scholarships and cultural events.

What is the Outstanding Performance in Sports Award?

This award recognizes exceptional athletic achievement, dedication, sportsmanship, and contributions to the school's sports program.

- **Athletic Excellence:** Medals (regional/state/national), school records, consistently high-level skills.
- **Dedication:** Regular practice attendance, commitment to improvement.
- **Sportsmanship:** Positive role model, respectful of teammates and opponents.
- **Contribution:** Active team participation, promoting sports within the school.
- **Leadership:** Team captain, mentoring younger athletes.
- **Academics:** Minimum 55% marks in each term.

What is the Excellence in Science Award?

This award recognizes outstanding achievement and passion in science.

- **Academic Excellence:** Consistently high grades/rank in science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology, etc.)
- **Scientific Understanding:** Demonstrating deep comprehension and application of scientific concepts.
- **Inquiry & Curiosity:** Strong interest in science beyond the curriculum (e.g., science fairs, projects).
- **Active Engagement:** Active participation in class discussions.
- **Future Potential:** Demonstrated aptitude and passion for science, suggesting potential future contributions.

What is the Excellence in Mathematics Award?

This award recognizes outstanding achievement and passion in mathematics.

- **Academic Excellence:** Consistently high grades/rank in mathematics.
- **Mathematical Proficiency:** Strong grasp of concepts, problem-solving, logical reasoning, and analytical skills.
- **Mathematical Thinking:** Critical and creative problem-solving abilities.
- **Interest & Engagement:** Enthusiasm for mathematics, participation in competitions/clubs/projects.
- **Active Participation:** Active engagement in class discussions.

What is the Noble Humanities Award?

This award recognizes outstanding achievement and passion in humanities disciplines (e.g., history, geography, literature, languages, social studies, social awareness).

- **Academic Excellence:** Consistently high grades/rank in humanities subjects.
- **Understanding & Analysis:** Deep comprehension and insightful interpretation of humanities concepts.
- **Critical Thinking:** Strong analytical skills and ability to formulate arguments.
- **Research & Inquiry:** Demonstrated interest in exploring humanities beyond the curriculum.
- **Communication Skills:** Excellent written and oral communication.
- **Passion & Engagement:** Genuine enthusiasm for humanities, active class participation.
- **Community Contribution:** Contributions to the school community in humanities-related activities.

Revocation of Awards

The Award may be revoked if the awardee:

- Submits false information during the application.
- Engages in academic dishonesty (cheating, plagiarism). Students who are fined or suspended are ineligible for awards during that academic year.
- Participates in misconduct (bullying, harassment, or unethical behavior).
- Fails to uphold the institution's values and principles.
- Discontinues studies before the academic year's completion.
